Uloric: FDA adds Boxed warning for increased death with gout medicine Uloric.

"The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) has concluded there is an increased risk of death with Uloric (febuxostat) compared to another gout medicine, allopurinol. This conclusion is based on our in-depth review of results from a safety clinical trial that found an increased risk of heart-related death and death from all causes with Uloric.... limiting the approved use of Uloric to certain patients who are not treated effectively or experience severe side effects with allopurinol.
